- **Service Providers:** We share data with trusted third-party vendors who assist us in operating our platform (e.g., cloud hosting, payment processing, email delivery). These providers are contractually bound to protect your data and only use it to provide their designated services.
- **Legal Compliance:** We may disclose your information if required by law, subpoena, or other legal process, or to protect the rights, property, or safety of the Company, our users, or others. You will be notified in writing prior to any disclosure.
- **Business Transfers:** If we are involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, your data may be transferred as part of that transaction.
